COURSE SUMMARY: Basic course instruction and behind-the-wheel experience to qualify students to obtain their driver's license. The state requires the students to have 30 hours of classroom instruction and six hours behind the wheel driving experience.

Student must have a valid learner's permit in hand on the first day of class.

The driver education classes currently offered at Beckman Catholic during the fall and spring semesters and during the summer sessions are provided by Northeast Iowa Community College (NICC). Students have the option of taking driver's education through a private instructor if one is available in their area. Since the driver education courses are offered through NICC, Beckman Catholic High School will NOT offer credit for the course. The course will NOT appear on the official transcript. The course will, however, count towards a student's required seven-class load.
